To clarify, Arbor will be used to send home communications via email or in-app messages and Seesaw will be used to share photos and videos of your child's learning in the classroom. It has been great to see so many parents and carers already interacting with posts showcasing learning in school, however, we can only post a photo of your child if we have your consent so please check and change your consents on Arbor if you haven't done so already.

Tonight, each child will bring home their individual Seesaw 'Home Learning' code which means they can log on to either the web or the app at home and complete any activities or homework their teachers have set as well as uploading any work they have done at home which they want to share with their teachers.
