### THIS HALF TERM'S LEARNING

### **Class Topic: Survival of the fittest**

In **DT**, we will be developing and applying the principles of a healthy and varied diet, preparing to cook a variety of dishes and understanding seasonality and knowing when and how a variety of ingredients are grown.

### **English:**

This half term we will be reading 'Fly Eagle Fly' as our core book. Throughout the teaching sequence, children will enjoy a story and discuss its themes and meanings, broaden their understanding of language used and build a bank of varied vocabulary and write a narrative from a character's perspective.

### **VIPERS**

This half-term we will be reading a range of non-fiction texts about nutrition and the different types of skeletons humans, animals and insects have. We will be focusing on summary, inference and retrieval style questions.

Maths: This half term we will be covering: - Mass and Capacity - Money - Time - Shape - Statistics	Science: We will be learning about Animals including humans. Throughout this unit, children will identify that animal including humans need the right types and amount of nutrients. They will also learn that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support and movement.	PE: In PE we will be playing cricket.
<b>PSCHE:</b> In PSHE we will be looking at relationships.	Modern Foreign Languages: We will be looking at French adjectives of colour, size and shape.	Music: In Music we will be learning and analysing jazz music.
